On February 1, 1971, [redacted] advised Edward Said is a Vice President of the AAUG. (~~Confidential~~). (u)

On October 13, 1972, [redacted] Columbia University, New York; New York; advised that her records contained the following information:

Edward William Said, who was born on November 1, 1935, in Jerusalem, Palestine, Social Security Number 150-28-8088, has been employed by Columbia University since July 1, 1963, first as an instructor, then assistant professor, associate professor and since July 1, 1970 as a Professor to date in the English Department. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Princeton University, has Master of Arts degree in 1960 from Harvard University and his Doctor of Philosophy degree from Harvard University in 1964. He was previously employed by Harvard University as a Teaching Fellow from 1959-1963. Her records also reflect Said is a United States citizen and he is married. He has resided at apartment 3B, 90 Morningside Drive, New York, New York, since October, 1971; at 419 West 115th Street, New York, New York, from May, 1970 to October, 1971; and prior to that at 910 West End Avenue, New York, New York, from April, 1965 to May, 1970.

October 13, 1972, the records of the Credit Bureau of Greater New York, were searched and found to contain no additional information concerning Said.
