BOB HERBERT, Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA), Loop 288 South, Denton, Texas, telephone number (817) 898-5104, was advised of the identity of the interviewing agent and the purpose of the interview. He then provided the following information.

As part of his official duties at FEMA, HERBERT received a copy of two "National Militia" identification cards from FEMA Headquarters, Washington, D.C.. At the top of the copy was the warning, "These are not official credentials. If spotted, challenge the holder." No other documentation or instructions were included with the document. HERBERT believes that the document actually originated at the Department of Defense. After the bombing of the Oklahoma City, Oklahoma Federal Building, HERBERT sent a copy of the identification cards to the Federal Protective Service, General Services Administration, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

HERBERT arranged to have a copy of the identification cards sent via facsimile transmission to Special Agent DAVID CUTHBERTSON, who placed the copy in the 1A section of the file.
