On March 26, 2002, Special Agents [redacted] and [redacted] accompanied by Victim Witness Specialist [redacted] proceeded to the residence of [redacted]. Upon arrival, they were greeted by [redacted] and [redacted] [redacted] PA September 11th Victim Advocate, headquartered in Doylestown, Pennsylvania.

[redacted] then used headphones and a cassette player to listen to a copy of a cassette tape currently in the custody of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. [redacted] was provided a transcription of this tape, which contained the audio of a 911 call made on September 11, 2001, by an individual who identified himself as [redacted] and who advised that he was a passenger aboard United Airlines Flight 93.

Pursuant to listening to the recording, [redacted] identified the voice on the tape as that of [redacted]

She then requested that [redacted] and [redacted] be provided an opportunity to hear the call. All individuals were provided as many opportunities as they wished to listen to the recording and/or to read the transcription.

When everyone who wished to hear the tape was satisfied, the visit to the residence was ended. The cassette tape containing the 911 call and its transcription remain in FBI custody.
