FBI Laboratory. Details: On April 2, 2005, explosive materials which were  
obtained by Kansas City from the ground beneath the crawl space  
in Terry Nichols' former residence, were charged out to the FBI  
Laboratory for analysis. Latent print analysis of these  
materials was conducted with no unidentified prints being found.  
No further examinations were necessary. The Laboratory number  
for this examination is 050402016.Communication in November 2007 with [REDACTED] of  
the Explosives Unit, OC SSA [REDACTED] and CDC John Mabry,  
determined that since no additional examinations were necessary,  
the materials could be destroyed by the Laboratory. On  
10/10/2008, [REDACTED] of the Explosives Unit confirmed all  
evidence from Laboratory number 050402016 was destroyed on April  
24, 2008 at the range at Quantico.b6
