All of the military forces in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina are now combined under the Federation Ministry of Defense and the Joint Command. President Clinton announced the launching of the Bosnia Train and Equip program on July 9, 1996. The training and advisory contract was signed by the Federation and the U.S. civilian contractor, Military Professional Resources, Inc. (MPRI) in Sarajevo on July 16. We are completing preparations for the shipment of U.S. defense equipment to the Federation and hope to complete delivery of all of the U.S. equipment by December 15.
