A confidential source in a position to provide information of this type advised as follows:

Source advised that one of the boxes contained a homemade cannon [redacted] the other boxes carried different types of rounds used for this homemade cannon. Another box had the fuses and electronic devices used to set off the cannon by remote control.

Source advised [redacted] had two M-1 carbine rifles [redacted] and one shorter-barreled M-1 rifle [redacted]

Source advised the selector switch for the M-1 which allowed these weapons to be fired fully automatic was carried [redacted]

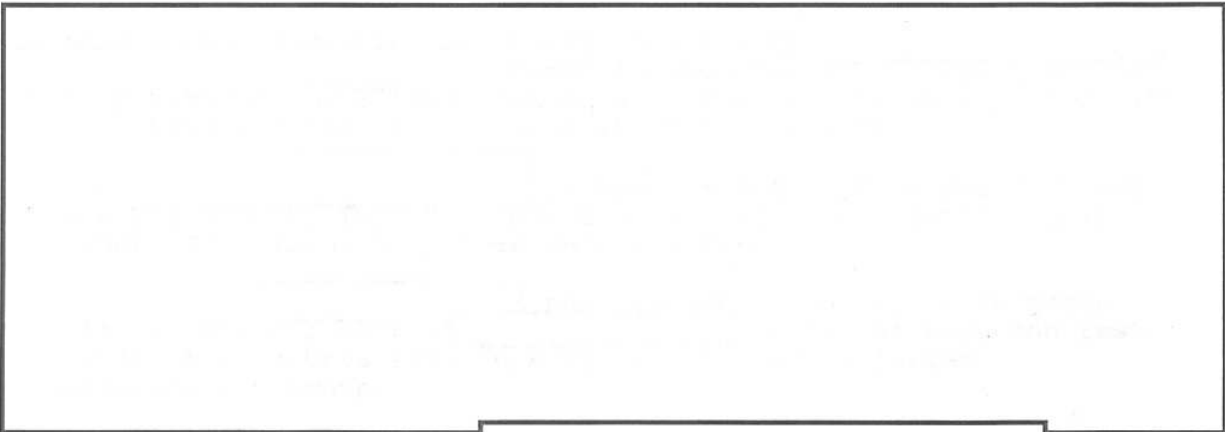
[redacted] were involved in a conversation about the world condition, catching up on old news, and things of this nature.

Source advised [redacted] discussed the concern by members of the TLI and other like groups about the "New World Order."

[redacted] the homemade cannon [redacted] was discussed.

Source advised [redacted] learned that [redacted] was involved in [redacted]

[redacted] met with [redacted] and [redacted]

[redacted] the TLI was joining forces with the TEXAS REENACTMENT GROUP (TRG), Company B, out of Houston, Texas, to form a larger TLI membership. [redacted] this will add 200 members to the number of people involved in TLI activities in Texas.

Source advised that [redacted] that the organization is currently being run by [redacted] it was apparent [redacted] that WATT still, although not in a leadership position, was dictating what the TLI was doing.

Source also learned that the new uniform for the TLI will be the raindrop design fatigues which are old East German

police uniforms which are being obtained by [redacted] Source advised these uniforms which can be picked up for a very inexpensive price are green in color with gold trim and that they wear a World War II type hat.

[redacted] if the joining of the forces between the TLI and the TRG works out that an additional 1,600 members of other TRG members will come into the TLI.

[redacted] the standard issue for this group will be the M-1 carbine [redacted] a belief that the rest of the TRG members will join the TLI to form a larger paramilitary group.

Source advised that all the members of the TLI and the TRG are afraid of the New World Order and what it might bring and that this is their way of joining forces together to protect their rights to bear arms. Source advised that members of these organizations all hate the current President, GEORGE BUSH.

Source advised that [redacted] has expressed the view that President BUSH, MARGARET THATCHER, MIKHAIL GORBACHEV, the ROCKEFELLERS, and the people who are involved in the Masons are involved in a conspiracy to form the so-called New World Order and take everyone's rights away.

Source advised that apparently [redacted] have a business agreement. [redacted] one set of books which are the official records of the business. Source advised, however, there is another set of books that is maintained [redacted]

Source advised that [redacted] are currently buying surplus ammunition and firearms and reselling the materials to members of the TLI and like groups at a profit but are not reporting the profits.

Source advised their business venture has been so successful that they are in the process of attempting to open another store in Houston, Texas, which will be run by [redacted] (LNU) who used to be [redacted] in the TLI who was recently promoted [redacted]. Source advised they are hoping to corner the market on ammunition and firearms in the Houston, Texas area.

Source advised that apparently this business venture is being financed [redacted]. Source advised that they are avoiding taxes and scrutiny by the IRS by using [redacted].

[redacted] Source advised that [redacted] will go to a wholesale business and purchase a large quantity of ammunition and firearms through the use of [redacted] [redacted] credit card. Source advised that because this is a credit card, it would appear as a private individual purchasing firearms and ammunition.

Once the ammunition and firearms have been shipped to [redacted] the ammunition and firearms are in turn sold at a profit to members of the TLI and other like groups. The profits from this sale are not shown. [redacted] apparently splits the money he makes between [redacted] after they have paid off the credit card bill which has accumulated.

[redacted] homemade cannon and one of the M-1 rifles [redacted] met with two other TLI members who were friends of both [redacted]. Source advised these members were never identified [redacted].

[redacted] he had picked out a building in Phoenix where [redacted] cannon on top of this building and could lob shells into the IRS and Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) buildings from the same location.

Source advised a meeting between [redacted] was supposed to have occurred at [redacted] because of [redacted] erratic and suspicious activity, [redacted] called off the meeting [redacted] did not know whether or not the two unidentified TLI members could possibly have been [redacted]

Source advised he was successful in getting some literature [redacted] One of the newsletters [redacted] called "The Balance," and the other newsletter [redacted] called "The Seditonist."

Source advised there was further discussion about the various military groups joining forces and one group being a

Source advised that on November 16, 1991, the convention began with a lecture by [Redacted]

[Redacted] gave a lecture on the much publicized DARE Program. [Redacted] alleged that this supposedly anti-drug program taught by the U. S. Government and other local government agencies is actually a conspiracy to control kids in school and is actually giving the message that it is okay to do drugs.

Source advised this lecture was followed by a lecture from [redacted] who is believed to be a member of the Ku Klux Klan (KKK) and wore a KKK pin on his collar. [redacted] talked about the AMERICAN PISTOL & RIFLE ASSOCIATION (APRA) and the work that this group does.

Source advised [redacted] was on the staff of the APRA Firearms Academy at Post Office Box USA, Benton, Tennessee 37307.

Source advised he at first felt that the lecture would be about gun control and safety but quickly learned from [redacted] lecture that the APRA Firearms Academy trained white supremacist and paramilitary groups on defensive tactics and how to shoot police officers before they can shoot you. According to [redacted] lecture, members of this group carry guns 24 hours a day and exhibit violent anti-government feelings.

Source advised that the next lecture was conducted by [redacted] of the U. S. Marine Corps. Unlike other lecturers who appeared at the convention, source advised that [redacted] requested that all recorders and TV cameras be turned off while he spoke on the topic of prisoners of war and missing in action (POW/MIA) [redacted] did not want to talk on the record about anything at this convention.

[redacted] went on to state that he agreed with other members of the convention that the New World Order, an expression coined in recent years, was actually a conspiracy to take rights from the Americans.

[redacted] also talked about four Americans who are known to be POWs in Laos and North Vietnam.

[redacted] also talked about interlocking anti-government groups so that the movement could be ready to fight the government when the government attempts to take over the rights of the citizens [redacted] also stated that he felt that the government's push to take away their rights will occur within the next two years.

Source advised that the interlocking movement among the right-wing extremists is a move to interlock groups throughout the United States making members of one group members of another group. This would increase communications and cooperation among

these groups so that when the time arrives that the government attempts to take away their rights, they will be united to fight the government.

Source advised that this interlocking procedure among these groups allows groups with different viewpoints but with the same common anti-government beliefs to join together.

Source advised that after [redacted] spoke [redacted] of the CMA, lectured about the direction the CMA was going to take in the future. [redacted] spoke about stockpiling things such as food items, military supply, and items of this nature to be ready for the day when all of these groups will have to fight the government to maintain their rights. [redacted] also talked extensively about the interlocking of groups for the defense of the rights of the people.

[redacted] Source advised that security was very tight around [redacted] and that security at the convention was being handled by [redacted]

Source advised that [redacted] also conducted sweeps of the rooms in which members had meetings looking for possible electronic eavesdropping devices.

Source advised that the security force at the convention was made up of skinhead members who were armed and carried walkie-talkies and flashlights. They patrolled the motel grounds looking for anyone who looked suspicious. Source advised that many of the skinheads had the word "skin" on their left arm.

Source advised [redacted] one of the skinhead members whose name was [redacted] (LNU) who talked about their group interlocking with the CMA.

[redacted] reportedly [redacted] were providing security at the convention who are all skinheads. According to source [redacted]

Source advised [redacted] that SCOTT (LNU) was [redacted] and that [redacted] that if anything came down where the government was attempting to suppress their rights [redacted] would know what to do at [redacted] plant. Source took this to mean he would sabotage the plant.

[redacted] was going to show his cannon to several members at the convention. Source advised that during the time that [redacted] was at the convention, he acted in a very erratic and suspicious manner. [redacted] continuously pressed people for questions about their organization, their names and addresses, and in what each organization was involved. Source advised that quickly [redacted] was put under suspicion as being an agent of the government, and people avoided him.

[redacted] had brought a homemade cannon to the convention and weapons that could be converted to fully automatic, many of the members at the convention believed that he was setting them up for possible arrest.

[redacted] and other members of the convention, it was agreed that [redacted] could not be trusted and that [redacted] would not get involved with [redacted] and these illegal weapons. It was a belief that possibly [redacted] was attempting to entrap [redacted] so that the authorities could arrest him.

Source advised that at one point, [redacted] was to view the cannon [redacted]

[redacted] told [redacted] that the cannon and the converted M-1 rifles (converted to full automatic) were illegal. [redacted] talked about using the cannon to hit buildings with explosive charges and things of this nature.

Source advised [redacted] was warned that he was not to talk about such matters and that they did not want to have

anything to do with these illegal weapons. [redacted]

[redacted] had very bad feelings about what was taking place. [redacted]

[redacted] thought he was being set up.

[redacted] looking at the weapon.

[redacted] that there was a lot of heat right now on people at the convention and that they did not want to have anything to do with [redacted] weapons.

[redacted] why the CMA was interlocking with hate groups such as the KKK. [redacted] some compromises had to be made and that the interlocking of the anti-government groups had to occur to fight the New World Order.

Source advised [redacted] the convention was under surveillance by the local sheriff and that an informant of [redacted] who was a member of [redacted] had obtained information that the local sheriff was surveilling the convention. [redacted] advised that security people at the convention believed that some of the rooms at the motel had had electronic eavesdropping devices placed in them. [redacted] they had almost caught some local law enforcement officers on the grounds and had in fact observed a police officer in an unmarked car sitting in the parking lot taking down license numbers.

Additionally, they observed the night before a strange individual in the bar at the convention who appeared out of place.

Source also advised that during the convention, a state helicopter with what appeared to be a video camera came over the convention center four times very low and appeared to be taking pictures of people at the convention.

Source also advised that during the convention, a minor "coup" had occurred. Source advised he had previously reported that many of the people in the CMA believed [redacted] was a Jew and that they wanted him out of a leadership role in the convention.

During the early days of the convention, a meeting took place where [redacted] was voted out as a member of [redacted] and was replaced with [redacted]

[redacted] became extremely paranoid. Source advised he started blaming the FBI and IRS again for all his problems and threatened retaliation against those agencies for causing him trouble again. [redacted] talked about [redacted] lobbing explosive rounds into both the IRS and FBI office space. [redacted] also accused [redacted] of the CMA who was at the convention as being a spy. [redacted] expressed extreme dislikes for Blacks and Jews. Source advised that [redacted] behavior became extremely erratic and irrational [redacted]
